Community Service and Enrichment deadline is approaching. Should a student fail to complete the community service requirement, he/she will be required to take a special community service make-up class over the summer at a cost of \$25.

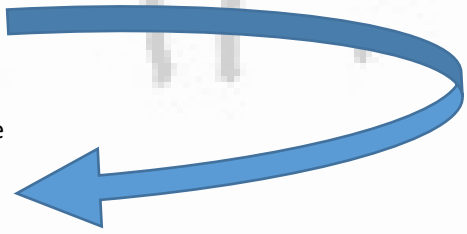


**All students:** Doors will open at 9:30 a.m.
