Lunch Status

Physicals

Parents, you will be receiving notification of your students health status (physicals/vaccines) this week. For students who have not had a physical within a year, they are able to have their physical and vaccines done for FREE at our ACCESS clinic. This information will be verified through the state health registry. Please note that your student will NOT be allowed to attend school without their physical, proof of vaccine or proof of an appointment, as of Friday, October 12th. Because of this, we are also including a letter that states all of this and will require a signature of confirmation. If signed letter is not return, your student will receive a LaSalle.
